CIS provides the following in support of Orange and Blue Construction.

Aligned with their vision to continually improve upon construction quality, our team has partnered with Orange & Blue for the past 5 years, working together to develop and implement a quality improvement process for superstructures that comprises an inspection, review and compliance program. The quality improvement process implements a system of checks and balances to verify and document construction compliance with technical specifications, industry standards, product manufacturers requirements and building codes. The elements of review include primary superstructures that are built with a combination of cast-in-place concrete decks and walls where Outinord type tunnel form assemblies are used; conventionally framed and formed structures to support reinforced cast-in-place concrete; post tensioned concrete and reinforced concrete masonry construction.

The CIS scope of work includes start-up meetings convened in the field with the Orange & Blue team and any supporting tradesmen to familiarize with the inspection and reporting process, to check plans, details and functionality in a field setting and review product submittals and technical information for materials approved for use by the design professionals of record. Upon commencement of the work, a regiment of field inspections are performed during construction to review work in progress up to final completion of the structures. A detailed reporting process designed to fit the needs of individual projects is in place to confirm that the work is documented as complete and facilitates the issuance final certificates of compliance.

During our tenure with Orange and Blue, they have demonstrated the ability to rise to the challenges of a growing and fast paced construction environment with attention to quality and detail. The synergy between the field and in-house teams exhibits the necessary strength, technical skills and problem solving to facilitate timely completion of their projects while maintaining high quality construction standards.

Measuring the quality of construction is essential to improvement. A well-balanced quality improvement program, coupled with continuing education, timely and consistent execution during construction improves construction quality, optimistically influence the end user, assist in speed to market and concludes with positive results for developers. All considered, we believe that the program implemented by Orange and Blue, such as described herein, produces high performance building envelope construction, with a byproduct being superstructures completed and delivered to the end user that are built in compliance with approved construction documents and industry recognized standards.
